INTENT

The themes for the year / areas of the curriculum to be studied / the big picture TO BE SHARED WITH STUDENTS (evidence in their books)
In this year you will begin by studying Creation, not so much scientifically as theologically. This is, as the unfolding of God’s plan for us and our world. You will have the opportunity to reflect on the Covenants God has made with Noah, Abraham and in greater depth the covenant with Moses. You will then prepare to celebrate the birth of Jesus and come to understand how he is the New Covenant. Then, you will explore the mystery of the Eucharist and Jesus’ passion, death and resurrection as a celebration of the New Covenant. The Christian section finishes by looking at the History of the Church in Britain where you will understand the privileges and freedoms we enjoy today thanks to the commitments of men and women. Finally, you will study Islam and understand how a different religion sees the world and what are some of their practices.
